SELECTION OF RECENT DOCTORAL VISITING RESEARCHER FOR THE **STRICTO SENSU** GRADUATE PROGRAMS OF UFMS

THE FEDERAL UNIVERSITY OF MATO GROSSO DO SUL FOUNDATION, through the Dean's Office of Research and Graduate Studies (Propp) and the Dean's Office of People Management (Progep), in the use of their legal attributions, motivated by the UFMS Institutional Development Plan (PDI 2020-2024) integrated to the Institutional Pedagogical Project (PPI), Resolution No. 17/2020-COUN, and by the Institutional Policy for Internationalization, Resolution No. 112/2021-COUN, makes public the opening of registrations for the Admission Process of Recent PhD Visiting Researcher UFMS in order to primarily strengthen the University's **Stricto Sensu** Graduate Programs, in compliance with Laws No. 8,745, of December 9, 1993, and No. 13, 445, of May 24, 2017, and their respective alterations, and in accordance with this Notice.

1. OBJECT

1.1. Hire up to 30 (thirty) recent PhD visiting researchers, national or foreign, in the year 2022, in order to strengthen and consolidate teaching, research, extension, entrepreneurship and innovation in the strategic and priority areas of UFMS and in partnership with the State of Mato Grosso do Sul, according to Resolution SEMAGRO/MS nº 743, of May 28, 2021.

2. OBJECTIVES

- 2.1. To encourage the insertion of qualified human resources in the strategic and priority areas of research at UFMS for the development of teaching and scientific, technological and innovative research in the Sectorial Administration Units (UAS) of UFMS that have Graduate Programs (PPGs), by hiring recent visiting researchers, as per Annex I;
- 2.2. Strengthen undergraduate and graduate teaching at UFMS;
- 2.3. Attract new researchers to the State of Mato Grosso do Sul;
- 2.4. Encourage the strengthening and expansion of research and innovation groups and actions in the UFMS PPGs, as development engines for Mato Grosso do Sul;
- 2.5. Stimulate partnership networks with national and international institutions, companies and industries, for the execution of innovative research and technology projects;
- 2.6. Improve the concept of UFMS PPGs in CAPES evaluation;
- 2.7. Strengthen UFMS's internationalization projects; and
- 2.8. Promote transformative interaction between UFMS and other sectors of society.

4. FINANCIAL RESOURCES AND VISITING RESEARCHER

4.1. The resources for the payment of expenses arising from this Notice are linked to the Work Program 12364107340090054 - Operation of Undergraduate Courses, Expense Element 3190-04 - Fixed-Term Contract, Source 100.

subject to the deadlines and limits for the commitment of expenses by the bodies, funds and entities of the Federal Executive Power and other higher regulations.

4.3. The remuneration of the Recent PhD Visiting Researcher, national or foreigner, will correspond to the remuneration of the Associate Professor A Level I of the Career of Higher Teaching, according to Law nº 12.772, of December 28, 2012, with a doctorate in a 40-hour shift, with the gross amount of R\$ 6,997.45 (six thousand, nine hundred and ninety-seven reais and forty-five cents).

4.4. There will be no requirement of exclusive dedication for the activities of the Recent PhD Visiting Researcher, being required dedication of 40 hours per week to the activities of teaching, research, extension and innovation, as approved in the Work Plan.

4.5. The Foundation for Support to Teaching, Science and Technology of the State of Mato Grosso do Sul (FUNDECT/MS), by signing an appropriate legal instrument, subject to budgetary and financial availability, will support each approved proposal with financial resources for funding, in the amount of up to R\$20,000.00 (twenty thousand reais), intended for the supervising professor of the proposal to fund the research activities approved in the Work Plan.

4.6. The annual investment by UFMS in this Notice will be with its own resources in the amount of up to BRL 5,038,165.44 (five million, thirty-eight thousand, one hundred and sixty-five reais and forty-four cents), and the amount of up to BRL \$ 600,000.00 (six hundred thousand reais) from FUNDECT/MS

5. REQUIREMENTS TO CLASSIFICATION A DEVELOPMENT OF THE WORK PLAN

5.1. For the recent PhD candidate:

a) hold a doctoral degree for at least 2 (two) years and for a maximum of 10 (ten) years, counting from the date of submission of the proposal;

b) be a professor or researcher of recognized competence in their area;

c) have **curriculum vitae** registered on the CNPq Lattes Platform, if Brazilian; **curriculum vitae** if equivalent to a foreigner, being one who is not born in Brazil according to Note 00157/2017/PROFED/PFFUFMS/PGF/AGU;

d) have regular scientific production in the last 5 (five) years, compatible with the Candidate's Technical-Academic-Scientific Production Score Table (Annex II), as of January 2017;

e) own ORCID (**Open Research and Contributors Identification**, <https://orcid.org/>);

f) not having exercised, in the last twenty-four months, activities as a visiting researcher based on Law No. 8,745, of December 9, 1993;

g) not be a servant of the direct or indirect administration of the Union, the States, the Federal District and the Municipalities, as well as an employee or servant of its subsidiaries and controlled companies; and



h) not have been definitively convicted of a crime, misdemeanor, or disciplinary penalty of dismissal or removal from public office or function.

5.2. The Work Plan (Annex IV) should have the following activities:

a) describe the objectives linked to the supervisor's research project and aligned with the priority areas for promoting research within the scope of UFMS and the Foundation for Support to the Development of Teaching, Science and Technology of the State of Mato Grosso do Sul (FUNDECT) (SEMAGRO Resolution /MS No. 743, of May 28, 2021):

b) teach, in-person and/or remotely, at least one discipline per year, in undergraduate courses at the University, in any Sectorial Administration Unit of UFMS, in the University City or on the Campuses, according to the planning and definition of the Dean's Office of Undergraduation (Prograd) from UFMS;

c) teach, in-person and/or remotely, at least one discipline per year, in graduate courses at the University, in any Sectorial Administration Unit of UFMS, in the University City or on the Campuses, according to the planning and definition of the Dean's Office of Research and Graduation (Prograd) from UFMS;

d) indicate the supervising researcher of the project: a teaching servant of the Career of Higher Teaching at UFMS accredited in a **Stricto Sensu** Graduate Program of the University, who will be responsible for monitoring and technical, scientific and innovation evaluation of the activities carried out by the researcher;

e) collaborate in the execution of a research project coordinated and under development by the supervising researcher indicated. The project will have to be registered and effective in the scope of the SIGProj of the UFMS;

f) to have, at least, one article Qualis A4 or superior accepted per year, during the execution of the contract of Visiting Researcher in the UFMS; and

g) to be available, in-person, of the supervisor and the Units of Sectorial and Central Administration of the UFMS during the

- 5.3. For the Project of Research:
- a) The research, development and innovation project, indicated for contribution in the UFMS in the related Work Plan will have to be registered by the supervisor as coordinator in the Project Information System (SIGProj), approved and effective in Dean's Office of Research and Graduation;
 - b) The research project must be related to at least one of the strategic areas selected below, in line with the UFMS Internationalization Plan (COUN Resolution No. 80 of August 30, 2018).

6. REGISTRATION AND EVALUATION PROCESS

- 6.1. Entries will be made **online** in the UFMS Project Information System (SIGProj), _ <http://sigproj.ufms.br>, respecting the deadlines set out in item 3 - Schedule.
- 6.2. The person responsible for the submission will be the candidate himself (Visiting Researcher), who will be called the proposal coordinator.
- 6.3. Proposals sent by any other means, whether electronic or physical, will not be accepted, nor after the deadline defined in this notice.
- 6.4. The proposal coordinator will receive the proposal submission protocol by **and e-mail** in his restricted area of SIGProj immediately after submission.
- 6.5. Propp is not responsible for submissions of proposals not received on time due to technical reasons, failures and/or congestion of communications lines, as well as other factors that make data transfer impossible.
- 6.6. Any false information provided by the coordinator of the proposal will lead to the cancellation of the proposal, in addition to the application of the appropriate administrative, civil and criminal sanctions, observing the contradictory and the full defense.
- 6.7. The following documents must be attached by the candidate, at the time of registration, via SIGProj, in PDF format:
- a) official document with photo;
 - b) CPF, in the case of a Brazilian candidate;
 - c) RNE (National Registry of Foreigners), passport and/or CPF, in the case of a foreign applicant (copy of the main pages of the passport);
 - d) undergraduate degree, master's degree (if any) and double-sided doctorate, or doctoral completion certificate;
 - e) **Curriculum Vitae**, which must be provided by the Lattes Platform for Brazilian candidates;
 - f) Indication of the name of the supervising researcher at UFMS, according to one of the strategic areas of the Public Notice. The supervisor must act in the line of research in which the candidate's research project will be developed, being obligatorily permanent professor of the Stricto Sensu Graduate Program.

g) Work Plan (Annex IV), indicating the UFMS **Stricto Sensu** Graduate Program (Annex I), title of the supervisor's research project, justification, objectives and the strategic areas of concentration in which it intends to work, highlighting the availability to teach undergraduate and **stricto sensu** graduate classes. The Work Plan must also contain a schedule that takes into account the deadlines for contracting;

h) Technical-Academic-Scientific Production Scoring Table (Annex II) duly filled in by the candidate; and

i) Statement by the supervisor who is interested in hiring the visiting researcher, indicating the positive aspects of their hiring and scientific, technological and innovation advances for UFMS.

6.8. The submission of the proposal does not guarantee its inclusion in the Public Notice.

6.9. The researcher must dedicate himself fully to the activities described in the approved Work Plan and, necessarily, participate in undergraduate and graduate teaching activities during the year, taking responsibility for the goals described in item 5.2. of this Public Notice, and in the development of research with a view to expanding the strategic competences of UFMS.

6.10. The stages of the proposal evaluation process are:

1. Step 1: Framework Analysis by the team of the Dean's Office of Research and Graduate Studies;

2. Step 2: Analysis of Merit and Technical-Scientific Relevance by the Scientific Committee; and

3. Step 3: Final Analysis by the team of the Dean's Office of Research and Graduate Studies;

7. STEP 1: FRAMEWORK OF THE PROPOSAL

7.1. The proposal will be framed by Propp's technical team, upon proof of compliance with all the requirements listed in this Notice, in particular items 5.1, 5.2, 5.3 and 6.7, and the result will be published in the Official Bulletin of UFMS and published on the website of Propp.

7.2. The framing of the proposal in this Stage does not guarantee its approval.

8. STEP 2: ANALYSIS OF MERIT AND TECHNICAL-

8.1. The Dean's Office of Research and Graduate Studies (PROPP) will establish a Scientific Commission composed of researchers, preferably CNPq research productivity grantees or with compatible scientific production, to assess the merit and scientific relevance of the Work Plan and curriculum of the tenderer.

8.2. The Scientific Committee shall analyze and evaluate the Candidate's Technical-Academic-Scientific Production Scoring Table (Annex



II) and fill in the Work Plan Score Table (Annex III), with the final score and "Recommended" or "Not Recommended" result, according to the strategic areas defined in this Notice.

9. STEP 3: FINAL ANALYSIS BY THE DEAN'S OFFICE OF RESEARCH AND GRADUATION

9.1. The final analysis of approval and approval of the proposal will be carried out by Propp, taking into account the strict compliance with the strategic areas listed in this Public Notice (item 5.3 b), consolidated by the PPG in its nomination.

9.2. For final approval decision by Propp, the proposals "Recommended" by the Scientific Committee and that meet the strategic areas must be forwarded to the Director of the Sectorial Administration Unit to which the UFMS **Stricto Sensu** Graduate Program is linked. The Unit Council shall analyze the Work Plan and issue a Resolution of the Supervisor's Sectorial Administration Unit Council, giving a favorable opinion or not to the hiring of the visiting researcher.

9.3. Only proposals classified with a score greater than or equal to 50 (fifty points) in the Score Table of the Work Plan (Annex III) may be selected, approved and ratified.

9.4. The final score of the proposal will be given by the sum of the scores of the two tables (Annex II and Annex III).

9.5. Following the descending order of the final score of the approved proposals, respecting the total number of vacancies that will be made available, the approval will be carried out in descending order of the score of the other proposals.

9.6. If there is a tie in the final score of the proposals, the one where the candidate is older will prevail.

9.7. Only proposals will be approved and ratified up to the limit of vacancies in the Public Notice. There will be no waiting list, and Propp may open new Notices for new vacancies, regardless of the classification of candidates in this Notice.

10. DURATION OF CONTRACT AND RENEWAL

10.1. The contracts must be prepared and celebrated by the Dean's Office of People Management (Progep) of UFMS.

10.2. The candidate who fails to prove the requirements specified in this Notice will be prevented from being hired.

10.3. The contract will have an initial term of 12 (twelve) months, and may be renewed for an equal period up to a total of 24 (twenty-four) months for Brazilian candidates, and up to 48 (forty-eight) months for foreign candidates, according to art. 5, item IV of Law 8745/1993, at the discretion of the Dean's Office of Research and Graduate Studies (Propp).

10.4. The researcher's contract will be renewed after analysis by the Dean of Research and Graduate Studies (Propp), based on the annual report of the activities developed and compliance with the goals of item 5.2, taking as a reference the Work Plan approved when of hiring.



10.5. The annual report must be submitted by the project coordinator through SIGPROJ, within the deadline defined by the Dean of Research and Graduate Studies (Propp).

10.6. The contracting and renewal will only be effective after approval of the budgetary and financial availability of UFMS through the Dean's Office of Planning, Budget and Finance (Proplan).

10.7. The renewal request must be sent to the Dean's Office of Research and Graduation Studies (Propp) by the UAS Director, with the partial reports duly finalized, within a minimum period of sixty days before the end of the contract.

10.8. In each 12-month period of execution of the Visiting Researcher's contract, Brazilian or foreign, the Dean's Office of Research and Graduation Studies (Propp) may not renew the contract, due to technical, administrative, budgetary and/or financial convenience, regardless of the payment to the contractor of any indemnity.

11. DISCLOSURE, PUBLICATION AND RESULTS OBTAINED DURING THE TERM OF THE

11.1. All disclosure and publication of any work resulting from the execution of the proposal must necessarily cite:

- a) Support from Federal University of Mato Grosso do Sul Foundation;
- b) support from CAPES, according to Ordinance 2016/2018, with the following text: "The present work was carried out with the support of the Coordination for the Improvement of Higher Education Personnel - Brazil (CAPES) - Financing Code 001" or "This study was financed in part by the Coordination for the Improvement of Higher Education Personnel - Brazil (CAPES)) - Finance Code 001";
- c) support from the Foundation to Support the Development of Teaching, Science and Technology of Mato Grosso do Sul (Fundect/MS);
- d) support from other funding agencies, when applicable.

11.2. Failure to comply with the requirements contained in Item 11.1 will give UFMS the unilateral right to cancel the proposal and any benefits granted, and not grant future resources to the proposal coordinator.

11.3. If the results of the project have commercial value or may lead to the development of a product or method, involving the establishment of intellectual property, the exchange of information and the reservation of rights, in each case, they will be carried out in accordance with the Term of Commitment signed and established in Law No. 13,243, of January 11, 2016, and the legislation of UFMS.

11.4. Advertising actions related to proposals and works financed with resources from the Union must strictly observe the provisions contained in §1 of art. 37 of the Federal Constitution, as well as those contained in the Instructions of the Secretariat for Government Communication and Strategic Management of the Presidency of the Republic - currently IN/SECOM-PR nº 7, of December 19, 2014.

reasons of public interest, government decrees or legal requirement, in a reasoned decision, without this implying rights to compensation or claims of any nature.

13. CHALLENGING THE NOTICE

13.1. The right to challenge the terms of this Notice before the UFMS will be voided by anyone who, having accepted it without objection, comes to point out, after the trial, any flaws or irregularities that have vitiated it, in which case such communication will not have the effect of appeal.

13.2. The objection must be addressed to the Dean's Office of Research and Graduation Studies at **e-mail** gab.propp@ufms.br .

13.3. The candidate who adheres to the conditions presented in this Notice will not be able to claim any vice or irregularity, and the presentation of his proposal will be considered as an irreversible agreement with the established conditions.

14. RESERVATION CLAUSE

14.1. The provisions of arts. 53 and 54; 57 to 59; 63 to 80; 97; 104 to 109; 110, items I, **in fine**, and II, sole paragraph, at 115; 116, items I to V, lines a and c, VI to XII and sole paragraph; 117, items I to VI and IX to XVIII; 118 to 126; 127, items I, II and III, to 132, items I to VII, and IX to XIII; 136 to 142, items I, first part, to III, and §§ 1 to 4; 236; 238 to 242, of Law No. 8,112, of December 11, 1990 are applicable to the visiting researcher.

14.2. The cases not covered by this Notice will be resolved by the Dean's Office of Research and Graduation Studies (Propp) and by the Dean's Office of People Management (Progep), according to their competences.

15. ADDITIONAL INFORMATION

15.1. The Sectorial Administration Unit, which has the PPG linked to the research project and the appointed supervisor, must meet the deadlines described in the schedule.

15.2. This Public Notice will be valid for six months after the approval of the final result, for hiring the Visiting Researcher, and it is not possible to have a waiting list for proposals.

15.3. The disclosure of this Notice will be carried out by UFMS on available platforms and official funding agencies.

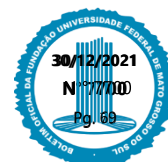
