UNIFIED SELECTION PROCESS OF **STRICTO SENSU** GRADUATE STUDIES
- MASTER 'S AND DOCTORATE 2025/1

BROAD COMPETITION, AFFIRMATIVE ACTIONS AND "QUALIFICA" PROGRAM
FOR BRAZILIAN AND FOREIGN CANDIDATES

The **FUNDAÇÃO UNIVERSIDADE FEDERAL DE MATO GROSSO DO SUL** through the Dean of Research and Graduate Studies - PROPP, in the use of its legal attributions, and considering Resolution No. 327/2024-COUN, Resolution No. 458/2021-COPP and Normative Instruction No. 10/2021-GAB/PROPP, makes public the opening of applications for the selection process of Brazilian and foreign candidates to fill vacancies in the master's and doctoral courses of the **Stricto Sensu** Graduate Programs (PPGs) of UFMS, for admission in the first semester of the academic year 2025, according to the provisions of this Notice.

I. PRELIMINARY PROVISIONS

I.1. The Selection Process will be governed by the rules set forth in this Notice, defined together with the Selection Committee of the Course Collegiates of each **Stricto Sensu Graduate Program of UFMS**, under the supervision of the Dean of Research and Graduate Studies - PROPP.

I.2. The list of professors linked to the Research Lines and other specific information of each Course can be found on the website of each Graduate Program (Appendix I).

I.3. The Selection Process of the exclusive postgraduate courses of UFMS is intended for Brazilian and foreign candidates holding a diploma, duly registered in Brazil, in accordance with the General Regulations of UFMS, according to the education required for entry into the respective Course contained in Appendix V.

I.4. The selection processes of the **Stricto Sensu** Graduate Programs in the National Network are not governed by this Notice and can be consulted at the electronic addresses available in Appendix II.

I.5. Expenses with participation in the Selection Process, as well as access to digital communication equipment, accommodation, food and transportation will be borne by the candidate, who will not be entitled to reimbursement of expenses by UFMS.

I.6. Doubts regarding this Notice may be clarified by the **email** selecao.propp@ufms.br and , additionally, by the **emails** of each PPG (Appendix I).

I.7. It is established for all purposes of this Notice, the official time of the State of Mato Grosso do Sul.

1.9. The Postgraduate Courses with vacancies in this Notice take place in the face-to-face modality.

2. OBJECTIVES

2.1. Select students to enter the master's and doctoral courses of the **Stricto Sensu** Graduate Programs - PPGs of UFMS.

2.2. Support the training and expansion of specialized human resources, with the integration between Brazilian and foreign students for the development of high-level scientific, technological and innovation research and implementation of an international environment.

2.3. Strengthen research and graduate studies in the State of Mato Grosso do Sul.

2.4. Foster research in strategic areas for institutional and global development, generating new knowledge in the consolidation of research and postgraduate studies in the State of Mato Grosso do Sul and in Brazil.

2.5. Promote the qualification of civil servants and support the training and enhancement of human capital in line with the Institutional Development Plan – PDI, integrated with the Institutional Pedagogical Project – PPI, and the People Management Policy of UFMS and strategic partners in the State of Mato Grosso do Sul with agreements with the University - "Qualifica" Program.

3. THE SCHEDULE

3.1. This Notice follows the following phase schedule:

4. **VACANCIES AND PREREQUISITES**

4.1. The number of vacancies for Brazilian candidates is included in Appendix III of this Notice, and there will be no limit on vacancies established for foreign candidates, provided that they are approved in the selection process governed by this Notice.

4.2. There may be direct admission to Doctoral courses, according to the rules regulated by the Dean of Research and Graduate Studies – PROPP and those provided by the PPG in Appendix V of this Notice.

4.3. The specific vacancies for the "Qualifica" Program of UFMS and partner institutions are listed in Appendix IV of this Notice.

4.4. The total vacancies available in this Notice are categorized in the modalities: Broad Competition, Affirmative Actions, "Qualifica" UFMS and "Qualifica" IFMS, as shown in the table below:

4.5. The not filled vacancies of the Affirmative Actions modality will be automatically converted into vacancies of the Broad Competition modality and can be used to call candidates on a waiting list.

4.6. The not filled vacancies of the Broad Competition and "Qualifica" Program modalities will be used to call candidates from the waiting list.

4.7. If there are remaining vacancies in the **Stricto Sensu** Graduate Programs related to this Notice, candidates on the waiting list of this Notice may be called only to enter the

first term of 2025.

4.8. Candidates for the master's course who are in the last year/semester of the undergraduate course and candidates for the doctorate who are pursuing a master's degree, if approved in the Selection Process, must present a complete academic record, diploma or equivalent document only at the time of register.

4.9. According to the requirements and information contained in Appendix V, regardless of the training and the undergraduate or master's degree course, the candidate must link his/her pre-research project proposal to one of the research lines of the Postgraduate Course.

5. VACANCIES RESERVED FOR PEOPLE WHO HAVE COMPLETED HIGH SCHOOL INTEGRALLY IN PUBLIC SCHOOL, BLACKS OR BROWNS, INDIGENOUS, QUILOMBOLAS, PEOPLE WITH DISABILITIES AND PEOPLE WITH ECONOMIC VULNERABILITY

5.1. Vacancies are reserved for people who completed high school entirely in a public school, black people, who declare themselves black or brown - PP, indigenous people, quilombolas, people with disabilities - PcD and people with economic vulnerability, provided that they are approved and classified in the selection process, obeying the provisions of COUN/UFMS Resolution No. 327, of January 25, 2024.

5.2. 20% of the vacancies offered by the respective Course will be reserved for affirmative actions, according to Appendix III.

5.3. In the event of fractional quantity for the number of vacancies reserved, it will be increased to the first subsequent integer.

5.4. The Regulatory Standards for Verification of Admission Conditions by Reservation of Vacancies for Affirmative Actions must comply with the provisions of COUN/UFMS Resolution No. 327, of January 25, 2024.

5.5. The self-declared candidate who has completed high school fully in a public school, black or brown person - PP, indigenous, quilombola, person with disabilities - PcD and person with economic vulnerability, if approved, must complete and send a self-declaration, according to Appendix VIII of this Notice, which will be analyzed by a Verification Board of the Veracity of the Self-Declaration, constituted by UFMS, according to the schedule established in item 3 of this Notice.

5.6. Proof of completion of high school in a public school will be made by presenting the High School Transcript.

5.7. Proof of the condition of a person with a disability - PcD will be made through the presentation of a medical report (Appendix VII) attesting to the type, or degree or level of disability, with express reference to the corresponding code of the International Classification of Diseases - ICD in force, as well as the probable cause of the disability, in accordance with the law (Decree No. 9.508/2018), issued in a period of less than one hundred and eighty days, from the date of opening of the enrollment to the selection process.

5.8. The candidate who declares himself indigenous to compete for the reserved vacancies, if selected, must prove condition through the

documentation listed in item 12.6, IV.

5.9. Proof of economic vulnerability will be carried out by proof of self-declared income upon presentation of the Summary Sheet of the proof of the Single Registry for Social Programs - CadÚnico.

5.10. The candidate who declares himself black (black or brown) to compete for the reserved vacancies, if selected, must send a photo and video, according to Appendix IX of this Notice, for verification and authorization of enrollment.

5.11. The candidate who declares himself to be a quilombola to compete for the reserved vacancies, if selected, must prove condition through the documentation listed in item 12.6, VIII.

5.12. In case of dropping out of approved vacancies, the vacancies will be filled by people who attended high school fully in a public school, black people, who declare themselves black or brown - PP, indigenous people, quilombolas, people with disabilities - PcD and people with economic vulnerability later classified.

5.13. If the candidate has already been evaluated by a Verification Board of the Veracity of the Self-Declaration, constituted by UFMS, it will not be necessary to undergo a new verification, remaining the previous result, even if it has been rejected.

5.14. Heteroidentification assessments carried out by an institution other than UFMS will not be considered.

5.15. Applicants registered in affirmative actions with a final grade higher than 6.00 and rejected in the Verification Board will be disqualified from the Selection Process.

6. ENROLLMENT

6.1. No registration fee will be charged for any Graduate Program in this Notice.

6.2. Enrollments will be made exclusively through the internet, within the period defined in the Schedule, item 3 of this Notice, at the electronic address <https://posgraduacao.ufms.br/portal> through an application form and compliance with the specific information of each Course linked to the Graduate Program contained in Appendix V of this Notice.

6.3. Each candidate may enroll in up to two Master's or Doctorate Courses among the vacancy offers in this Notice. If the candidate enrolls in more courses, only the last two enrollments will be considered valid. It is the candidate's responsibility to verify the non-overlapping of dates and times in the selection process of the enrolled courses.

6.4. To enroll, the candidate must perform the following steps:

a) access the electronic address <https://posgraduacao.ufms.br/portal>;

b) select the "Inscrições" link (Enrollment link);

c) click on "Processo Seletivo Unificado de Pós-Graduação **Stricto Sensu - Mestrado e Doutorado 2025.1**" (**Stricto Sensu** Unified Graduate Selection Process - Master's and Doctorate 2025.1);

- d) opt for the desired course;
- e) complete the “Ficha de Inscrição” (Enrollment Form);
- f) indicate the modality of competition of the vacancy: broad competition, affirmative actions or “Qualifica” Program (select the partner);
- g) attach the specific documents required by the intended postgraduate course, as per Appendix V; and
- h) click on “Finalizar Inscrição” (Finish Enrollment).

6.5. The applicant must attach, obligatorily, in the Enrollment Form the documents required according to Appendix V.

6.6. Registrations not completed in the <https://posgraduacao.ufms.br/portal> system will not be considered for the purpose of granting or rejecting.

6.7. After finalizing the enrollment, the candidate who needs to change some information of his/her registration may, during the enrollment period, according to the schedule contained in item 3 of this Notice, reverse the enrollment status by clicking on “Ações” (Actions) and then “Reverter Status” (Revert status). After making the necessary changes, the candidate must finalize the application again during the application period.

6.8. At the end of the application, the candidate is aware of and agrees with the rules of the Unified Selection Process established in this notice.

6.9. UFMS will not be responsible for requests for registrations not received due to technical reasons of computers, communication failures, congestion of communication lines, lack of electricity, as well as other technical or meteorological factors that make it impossible to transfer data.

6.10. The candidate will only be considered enrolled in the Selection Process after having complied with all the instructions provided for in this Notice, and included in the Notice of approval of enrollments.

6.11. The candidate must register a valid electronic address (**email**) at the time of registration, which will be used as a means of communication by UFMS with information about the Selection Process.

6.12. The candidate approved by the UFMS “Qualifica” Program vacancies, when registering, is aware that he/she will not be entitled to full leave, per diems or UFMS tickets to participate in the course.

7. DIFFERENTIATED SERVICE OR SERVICE OF SPECIAL CONDITIONS TO CARRY OUT THE TESTS

7.1. The candidate with special needs who needs differentiated care must request the type of care necessary for the Selection Process, at the time of **online** registration, sending the request for differentiated care (Appendix VI) and the medical report (Appendix VII) with express reference to the corresponding code of the International Classification of Disease – ICD that justifies the service. The candidate may also request, if necessary, additional time, limited to 60 minutes, to take the tests, as provided for in art. 30, item V, of Law No. 13.146 of 06/06/2015.

7.2. The procedure described in sub-item 7.1 will be used to adopt criteria for evaluating the written test, considering the linguistic uniqueness of the person with disabilities, in the field of the written modality of the Portuguese language, pursuant to art. 30, item VI, of Law No. 13.146 of 06/06/2015.

7.3. The mother is assured the right to breastfeed her children up to 6 (six) months of age during the performance of tests. The lactating candidate who needs to breastfeed must bring a companion over 18 (eighteen) years old, who will be in a reserved space and will be responsible for the child during the mother's absence while she performs the evaluations, and there can be no communication from them regarding questions about the evaluations.

7.4. The candidate who does not bring a companion to be responsible for the child will not be allowed to take the test.

7.5. In evaluations lasting more than 2 (two) hours, the candidate may be absent at each interval of 2 (two) hours, for up to 30 (thirty) minutes and will have the time spent on breastfeeding compensated during the test, in the same period, according to § 2 of art. 4 of Law No. 13.872, of September 17, 2019.

7.6. The request for differentiated service will be met within the technical possibilities of UFMS, subject to the evaluation and favorable opinion by the Selection Committee of the Course Collegiate.

7.7. The applicant must be aware that the information provided on the condition that motivates the request for differentiated service must be accurate and reliable, under penalty of being liable for a crime against public faith and being eliminated from the Selection Process.

7.8. In accordance with art. 27 of Decree No. 3.298 of 12/20/1999, non-compliance by the candidate with Special Needs, as provided for in sub-item 7.1, exempts UFMS from meeting the request for differentiated service.

8. STEPS OF THE SELECTION PROCESS

8.1. Each Graduate Program (PPG) will appoint a Course Selection Committee formed by the members of the Course Collegiate and/or teachers of the Course, who will be responsible for analyzing the documentation required at the time of registration, as provided in Appendix V, and for **the Merit Evaluation Stage of the project/candidate**.

8.2. The Selection Committee will be published by the Head of the PPG Sectoral Administration Unit, according to Schedule item 3.

8.3. Steps of the selection process:

I - Registration approval stage, under the management of the Dean of Research and Graduate Studies - PROPP;

II - Merit evaluation stage of the project/candidate, under the management and responsibility of the Course Selection Committee, in the period established in item 3 of this Notice, in accordance with Appendix V of each PPG;

III- Language proficiency assessment stage (English or

Spanish to Brazilian, as defined by the PPG in Appendix V).

8.4. Each Graduate Program/Course will carry out the merit evaluation stage in accordance with the provisions of Appendix V of this Notice.

8.5. The stage of the selection process - **Merit evaluation stage**, under the responsibility of the Selection Committee of each Course Collegiate, may cover all or some of the types of **evaluation** below:

I - Curriculum analysis: through the candidate's Lattes Curriculum, generated by the CNPq Lattes Platform (<http://lattes.cnpq.br/>), in the case of Brazilians, and/or Curriculum Vitae for foreigners; and Score Table of the candidate's Lattes curriculum, according to specific information of the course completed in the last five years (2020 to 2025). The Selection Committee of each course may request proof of publication of the articles or other items indicated in the Score Table. **For candidates who took Maternity or Adopter Leave during the evaluated period, scientific, technological and/or artistic production from the previous year will also be considered, in line with the Sou Mulher UFMS Program.** In order to be considered in the Curriculum Analysis, candidates in this condition must register the **Maternity or Adoptive Leave** in the Curriculum and attach it to the file of the vouchers contained in the curriculum score table of the additional year.

II - Analysis and/or presentation of the pre-project, with objective evaluation criteria defined by the Course Collegiates of each PPG, which may be remote or in person at the time and place indicated by the PPG in Appendix V, the indication may occur on the program page or by sending an email to the candidate;

III - Proof of specific knowledge, with themes and/or basic bibliography indicated by each PPG, carried out in the virtual AVA environment of UFMS or in person at the time and place indicated by the PPG in Appendix V, and the indication may occur on the program page or by sending an email to the candidate;

IV - Use of national evidence grades of the area (Appendix V); and/or

V - Undergraduate Academic Transcript (Appendix V).

8.6. **The Language Test (English or Spanish for Brazilians, as defined by the PPG in Appendix V, or Portuguese for foreign candidates from non-Lusophone countries)** will be carried out **online**, in the AVA virtual environment of UFMS, by the team of the Institutional Extension Program "PROJELE-UFMS", according to the Schedule defined in item 3 of this Notice and with the guidelines below:

a) The Language Test is not eliminatory for entry into the **Stricto Sensu** Graduate Course, according to the rules of this selection process notice, and its completion is not mandatory for entry into the course.

b) It will consist of a foreign language test with 10 objective questions lasting 2 hours, being carried out **online** and will be evaluated on a scale from 0.00 (zero) to 10.00 (ten).

c) Tests can be taken in both languages, only for

candidates for Courses that require proficiency in two languages, English and Spanish, as per Appendix V.

- d) The link to the Ava Moodle for the test will be published on the Propp page.
- e) The candidate must access the Ava Moodle link in the period to be indicated in the publication of the link and according to the guidelines disclosed on the Propp page in order to have the opportunity to become familiar with the system.
- f) The language test will be available on Ava Moodle between 8:00 am and 10:00 pm according to the schedule in item 3.
- g) The candidate must complete the test by 10:00 pm on the day of application of the test.
- h) The Course Collegiate Selection Committee and the Dean of Research and Graduate Studies - PROPP are not responsible for tests not carried out due to technical reasons of computers, access with incorrect login, communication failures, congestion of communication lines, lack of electricity, as well as other technical or meteorological factors that make it impossible to transfer data.
- i) If approved in the selection process, the classified candidate who has not taken the test or achieved a grade of 7.00 (seven), may retake the Language Test during the course or according to the deadline established in the Program Regulations or may present proof of proficiency of the required language, according to Appendix V, in the enrollment or during the term of the course, according to the deadline established in the Course Regulations, considering the minimum established in the following table:

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8.7. If requested in the course selection process, the pre-research project must be prepared by the candidate following the rules and structure defined by each PPG, according to Appendix V, and **must** adhere to one of the research lines of the Postgraduate Course.

8.8. The schedule, the evaluations of the Merit Evaluation Stage, the program content, the criteria for curriculum analysis, the criteria for evaluating the pre-research project, if any, and the calculation of the candidate's final grade are included in the specific information of each course, according to Appendix V.

8.9. In the Merit Evaluation Stage, when carrying out the elimination evaluation, as defined in Appendix V, after each evaluation, the PPG must publish the result, duly motivated by the Selection Committee, as well as the respective deadlines for appeals.

8.10. The technological resources necessary to carry out the evaluation steps are the sole responsibility of the candidate.

8.11. The Course Collegiate Selection Committee and the Dean of Research and Graduate Studies - PROPP are not responsible for tests not carried out due to technical reasons of computers, access with incorrect login, communication failures, congestion of communication lines, lack of electricity, as well as other technical or meteorological factors that make it impossible to transfer data.

8.12. The research pre-projects, written tests and/or videos with the recordings of the pre-project defenses of all approved and disapproved candidates will be filed for up to one year after the approval of the selection process, ensuring the right of access through the request duly filed with the Program Secretariat.

8.13. The candidate will only be allowed to carry out the evaluations on the respective date and time listed in the schedule in Appendix V.

8.14. The non-attendance of the candidate and the non-performance of the activities on scheduled dates and times, characterizes the candidate's withdrawal and will result in his/her elimination in this Selection Process.

8.15. The verification of absence or irregularities in the files of mandatory documents, specified in Appendix V, attached to the Graduate Portal, at any time characterizes the candidate's withdrawal and will result in its elimination in this Selection Process.

8.16. The start time of the evaluations may be delayed for justifiable reasons, without affecting their duration.

9. THE FINAL RESULT

9.1. At the end of the Merit Evaluation Stage, each PPG must send for publication by the Dean of Research and Graduate Studies - PROPP the result of all evaluations adopted, with a grade from 0.00 to 10.00, duly motivated by the Selection Committee, according to the rules defined in this Notice.

9.2. The evaluation scores that are not in the scale from 0.00 to 10.00 will be normalized, that is, classified in the scale 0.00 to 10.00 for publication of the final result.

9.3. After the administrative appeals period, the Selection Committee of each PPG will inform Propp of the partial results of each evaluation and the final selection result in accordance with the terms of this Notice.

9.4. The final grade and classification will be disclosed by the courses, duly motivated by the Selection Committee and the final result will be sent to the Dean of Research and Graduate Studies - Propp to approve the result of the selection and call for registration.

9.5. All candidates with a final grade equal to or greater than 6.00 will be approved, according to the number of vacancies in each PPG.

10. ADMINISTRATIVE APPEALS

10.1. The applicant may request recourse to the result of the approval of the registrations, language test, evaluations of the merit evaluation stage and the final result, and must use a specific form (Appendix X), according to the deadlines stipulated in the schedule (item 3).

10.2. Appeals regarding the result of the approval of the registrations, proof of languages and the final result, must be sent to selecao.propp@ufms.br, containing the object in the description of the subject as follows: Recurso – resultado da homologação das inscrições (Appeal – result of the approval of the registrations); Recurso - prova de línguas (Appeal - proof of languages), depending on the appeal to be filed.

10.3. With regard to the merit evaluation stage, a single appeal will be admitted per evaluation, per candidate, to be sent to the **email** of the specific postgraduate course contained in Appendix I, with a copy to selecao.propp@ufms.br, containing, in the description of the subject of the email, which evaluation refers to the following: Recurso – Prova de Conhecimentos Específicos (Appeal – Proof of Specific Knowledge); Recurso - Análise do Pré-Projeto (Appeal - Pre-Project Analysis); Recurso - Defesa do Pré-Projeto (Appeal - Defense of the Pre-Project); Recurso - Análise de Currículo (Appeal - Curriculum Analysis); Recurso - Resultado e Nota Final (Appeal - Result and Final Grade), depending on the appeal to be filed.

11. CLASSIFICATION AND APPROVAL

11.1. Qualified candidates will be ranked in descending order of final grade.

11.2. In case of a tie in the final grade, the candidate who:

a) has the highest Curriculum Analysis score;

b) has an age equal to or greater than sixty years, until the last day of enrollment in the Selection Process, according to art. 27, Sole paragraph

of Law No. 10.741, of 2003 (Elderly Statute), among them the oldest one;

c) is of higher age (in the case of those who do not fit the letter "d").

**GUIDELINES FOR PARTICIPATION IN A PANEL TO VERIFY THE VERACITY OF THE SELF-
DECLARATION OF BLACK OR BROWN CANDIDATES**

1. The candidate summoned for enrollment in vacancies reserved for black or brown people must send at the time of enrollment the self-declaration of black or brown person, duly completed (Appendix VII), a photograph and a video, according to the specifications below.
2. The photograph must be individual, recent, in JPG format, with a maximum size of 3 MB and comply with the following guidelines:
 - a) front, taken 1.5 meters from the candidate, sitting with open hands on the knees;
 - b) the environment should be well lit and with a white background;
 - c) without any makeup;
 - d) no sunglasses
 - e) no hat, cap or beanie;
 - f) without using editing filters; and
 - g) hair naturally loose and without any prop.
- 2.1. Name the photo file with the applicant's name and current year, for example: "nomedocandidato_ano" ("nameofthecandidate_year").
3. The video must be individual, recent and comply with the following guidelines:
 - a) if it is recorded using a cell phone, the device must be kept in a horizontal position;
 - b) use indoor environment for recording, with good lighting;
 - c) prevent light from entering behind the image;
 - d) preferably be positioned in a place with a white background;
 - e) without any makeup;
 - f) no sunglasses
 - g) no hat, cap or beanie;
 - h) without using editing filters; and
 - i) if necessary, use headphones; and
 - j) hair naturally loose and without any prop.
- 3.1. In the video, the candidate should ONLY say his/her full name, the name of the course and the current year. Speak the following script at the beginning of the video: "MY NAME IS (full name of the candidate) and I ENROLLED IN UFMS FOR the COURSE (course for which I enrolled) IN the YEAR (current year)".
- 3.2. The recorded video must comply with the following technical settings:
 - a) the video recording must have a preferred resolution of 720P (maximum accepted resolution of 1080P) AT 30 fps and in MP4 format;
 - b) the duration of the video should preferably be around 15 seconds (not to exceed 30 seconds);
 - c) the size of the video file should preferably be up to 50 MB (not to exceed 100 MB); and
 - d) if the video size exceeds the limit accepted by the system, a new recording with a lower resolution must be made and sent.
- 3.3. Name the photo file with the applicant's name and current year, for example: "nomedocandidato_ano" ("nameofthecandidate_year").
4. Photographs and videos that are not clear or in disagreement with this Notice will be rejected, and the applicant must forward a new file (photograph or video) during the administrative appeal period.
5. The Veracity Verification Board of the Self-Declaration will verify, through photography and video, the following phenotypic characteristics considered characteristic of black or brown people: brown or black skin color, curly or curly hair, wide nose and thick and brownish lips.
6. Failure to send the photo or video by the candidate, within the deadlines defined in the Notice, implies the automatic loss of the vacancy.
7. Self-declaration checks carried out by institutions other than UFMS will not be considered.
